

St. Scholastica is the patron saint against storms. The story April 28, 2024 below details how St. Scholastica spent one evening with her

brother during a violent storm. During this Spring season in Tennessee we will witness many thunderstorms. When you are scared remember to ask St. Scholastica to come to your aid. Through her own love God came to her aid that night. Through Jesus' resurrection God shows us his love for us and that he will come to our aid in the hour of

need.



Prayer

St. Scholastica, we pray, O Lord, that following her example, we may serve you with pure love and happily receive what comes

from loving you. Amen



You can take a toilet paper or paper towel tub and cover the ends with paper using glue or a rubber band. Ask for help to fill it with tiny rocks, rice, or beans. Turn the tub over and listen to it "rain".

Saint Scholastica also had a brother who became a Saint. His name was Saint Benedict. Both of the siblings had devoted their lives to God and despite living near each other the siblings only saw each other once a year. During the evening of their day together, Saint Scholastica did not want the day to end. She enjoyed her time with her brother talking about God. Saint Benedict knew evening was coming and needed to back to his home. Saint Scholastica prayed to God and a huge storm came, which forced Saint Benedict to stay all night long, which made her happy!

God is love. He loves us so much he sent his only son to walk among us and to save us. Take a moment to consider the depths of the love God has for us. St. Scholastica wanted to know that love through her whole being and rejected anything that would come between her and God's love. Do we yearn for God's love too? Do we prioritize that love in our

lives?

When St. Scholastica died her brother saw an image of a dove in his dreams. He went a collected her and she was buried in a grave that was meant for him. Years later when he died he was buried with his sis-
