# What is the Legion of Mary?

The Legion of Mary is the largest apostolic organization of lay people in the Catholic Church, with well over 3 million active members in almost every country in the world. It has been active in the United States since 1931, has been approved by the last 6 Popes, and was endorsed by the second Vatican council. The main purpose of the Legion of Mary is to give glory to God through the sanctification of its members.

### What does it do?

Members become instruments of the Holy Spirit through a balanced program of prayer and service. Works include parishioner visitation, prison ministry, visitation of the sick or aged, crowd contact, religious education, door-to-door evangelization, youth work, and other spiritual needs of the parish and community. It gives Catholics from 8 years up an opportunity to do something positive for the Church while at the same time deepening their spiritual life and strengthening their Catholic faith.

## How much time is involved?

Members meet together once a week for prayer, planning and discussion in a family setting; they do a couple of hours of definite work each week in pairs and under the guidance of a spiritual director.

# Who can belong?

Any practicing Catholic, young, not-so-young, single, married, retired, man or woman, who would like to draw closer to Jesus and His Mother is welcome.
