Register by Aug. 30 to secure your room. Refunds if retreat is cancelled.




Helping Hands Clothes Closet at Ave Maria NEEDS your helping hands!



Prayer To Saint John Bosco



Once home the dog just watched him walk inside. St. John Bosco saw the dog often and he gave him the name, Grigio, which meant gray. The dog came to his aid many times when St. John Bosco's life was at risk.

order to fully live we need a relationship with God.






