# Fr. Carlos Donato da Silva, JCL Biography

Fr. Donato was born in Brazil on September 18, 1983. He entered Seminary formation in 2001, in Brazil. In 2001 he earned his Master of Philosophy in Brazil. He was sent to study theology in Rome at the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross. In 2012 he did his Hispanic language training and immersion on Mexico for a year. Fr. Donato received his Master of Divinity from Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans and was ordained a priest at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017. He received his license in Canon Law from University St. Paul in Ottawa, Canada in 2023 and a Master in Canon Law from the University of Ottawa, Canada in the same year. Fr. Donato was the Vice-chancellor of the Diocese of Memphis from 2018-2021. He is an Advocate and promoter of Justice for the Diocesan tribunal.

# P. Carlos Donato da Silva, JCL Biografía

El P. Donato nació en Brasil el 18 de septiembre de 1983. Ingresó a la formación en el seminario en 2001, en Brasil. En 2001 obtuvo su Maestría en Filosofía en Brasil. Fue enviado a estudiar teología a Roma, a la Universidad Pontificia de la Santa Cruz. En 2012 realizó su formación en lengua hispana y una inmersión en México durante un año. El P. Donato recibió su Maestría en Divinidad del Seminario de Notre Dame en Nueva Orleans y fue ordenado sacerdote en la Catedral de la Inmaculada Concepción el 3 de junio de 2017. Recibió su licenciatura en Derecho Canónico de la Universidad St. Paul en Ottawa, Canadá en 2023 y una Maestría en Derecho Canónico de la Universidad de Ottawa, Canadá en el mismo año. El P. Donato fue vicecanciller de la Diócesis de Memphis de 2018 a 2021. Es Abogado y promotor de Justicia para el Tribunal Diocesano.



Prayer

Saint Peregrine,
Pray for Us!

O God, in St. Peregrine You gave us an outstanding example of faith and patience. We humbly ask You that by imitating him and by the help of his prayers, we may believe more fully in Your healing help, bear the suffering of this life without wavering, and come with joy to the peace of heaven.

Saint Peregrine was born into a wealthy family. However, they were not Catholic and did not like the faith. Saint Peregrine grew up learning this from his family and believed it too. He even hit a priest but was then shocked with the man's calmness. He immediately apologized and not long later decided to join the priest-hood. Saint Peregrine had cancer in his leg and the doctor told him that it would have to amputated to save his life. He went to a church and prayed. Even though he didn't feel tired he found himself falling asleep. While asleep, he had a dream that Jesus came down off the cross and gently touched his leg healing it. He woke up startled and realized that his leg was actually healed.

The Gospel today is a story very similar to St. Peregrine. Jesus healed both men and both men proclaimed the miracle to those around them. We hear, "He has done all things well." Sometimes we forget those words. Even when things are not going our way we need to remember God is with us always.



Our Lady of Miraculous Medal appeared in 1830 in Paris, France to a novice at a convent. The Lady asked for a specific medal be made in her honor saying that all who wear it would receive great graces. The medal was produced and is known as the Miraculous Medal because of the many miracles attributed to it. The front has an image of the Lady as the novice described and the back is a letter M with a cross.



Saint Peregrine became known for his preaching, holiness, and his devotion to the sick and poor. He imposed a special penance to himself that he would stand when it was not necessary to sit. Over time, he developed varicose veins from standing so much and eventually cancer of his leg or foot. He endured a lot of pain and failed treatment for his condition until it was miraculously cured.
