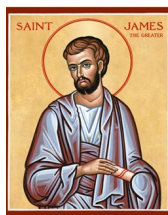

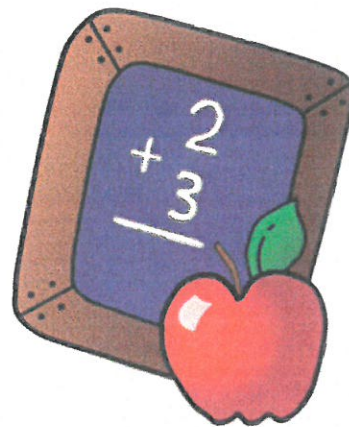
School Supplies Drive
