HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception falls on a Saturday, it is still a <u>Holy Day of obligation</u>. However, all Saturday evening Masses need to be celebrated for the 2nd Sunday of Advent. Therefore, Immaculate Conception Masses should be celebrated Saturday before the first Vespers for the 2nd Sunday of Advent, or Friday evening, Dec. 7th, after the 1st Vespers for the Immaculate Conception. To fulfil this obligation St. Alphonsus/Ave Maria Mass schedules are:

Friday, December 7th at Ave Maria at 6:00 pm Saturday, December 8th at St. Alphonsus at 8:30 am

A feast called the Conception of Mary arose in the Eastern Church in the seventh century. It came to the West in the eighth century. In the 11th century it received its present name, the Immaculate Conception. In the 18th century it became a feast of the universal Church. It is now recognized as a solemnity. Two Franciscans, William of Ware and Blessed John Duns Scotus, helped develop the theology. They pointed out that Mary's Immaculate Conception enhances Jesus' redemptive work. Other members of the human race are cleansed from original sin after birth. In Mary, Jesus' work was so powerful as to prevent original sin at the outset.
