Stations of the Cross



The Stations of the Cross provides us with an opportunity to meditate on the passion and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. This devotion will be held at St. Alphonsus at 7:00 p.m. every Friday during Lent. On Good Friday, Stations will be held at 3:00 p.m.

Lenten Penance Service

A Penance Service will be held at St. Alphonsus on Monday, April 1, at 6:30 p.m. *Canon law states that "After they have reached the age of discretion, all the faithful are obliged to confess serious sins at least once a year.*" Receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a good way to prepare for Easter.

Eucharistic Fast

Canon law states, "One who is to receive the most Holy Eucharist is to abstain from any food or drink, with the exception only of water and medicine, for at least the period of one hour before Holy Communion" (CIC 919). The elderly, the sick, and their caretakers are excused from this obligation. *Chewing gum breaks the Eucharistic fast, and therefore should not be used an hour before Mass. Also, one should NEVER receive Holy Communion with chewing gum in one's mouth, and food or drink should not be brought into the Church.*

Fr. Robert Szczechura will be leading a Eucharistic Minister Training class at St. Francis of Assisi on Saturday, April 6th from 9am - 3pm. Pre-Registration, including the participant's pastor approval, is required. Please pick up a registration form in the parish office.

Welcome Bishop David P. Talley



Pope Francis on March 5, 2019, appointed as bishop of the diocese of Memphis, Bishop David P. Talley, bishop of Alexandria.

Bishop David Prescott Talley was born on September 11, 1950, in Columbus, Georgia, in the diocese of Savannah. After attending Hardaway High School, he obtained a bachelor's degree in philosophy from Auburn University, Alabama, and a master's degree in social work from the University of Georgia in Athens, Georgia. He worked as a social worker for several years. He then entered the seminary and

carried out his ecclesiastical studies at the Saint Meinrad School of Theology in Saint Meinrad, Indiana (1985-1989). He later obtained a licentiate (1995) and a doctorate (1997) in canon law from the Pontifical Gregorian University, Rome.

He was ordained as a priest of the Archdiocese of Atlanta on June 3, 1989. Since ordination he has held the following positions: parish vicar of the Saint Jude the Apostle parish in Sandy Springs (1989-1993); director of priestly vocations (1998-2001); chancellor (1999-2001); administrator of Saint Matthew parish in Tyrone (2001); judicial vicar (2001-2003); director of the Saint Thomas Aquinas parish in Alpharetta (2003-2006); parish vicar of the Saint Anne parish in Columbus (2006-2007); parish priest of Saint John Neumann parish in Lilburn (2007-2011); member of the archdiocesan Hispanic Ministry Board (2008-2011); parish priest of Saint Brigid Parish in Johns Creek (2011-2013).

In 2000 he was named Prelate of Honor of His Holiness.

He was appointed as titular bishop of Lambaesis and auxiliary of Atlanta on January 3, 2013 and received episcopal consecration on April 2, 2013.

As auxiliary bishop he served as vicar general and vicar for the clergy.

He was appointed as coadjutor bishop of Alexandria, Louisiana, on September 21, 2016, and on February 2, 2017, he was appointed as ordinary.

Within the Episcopal Conference, he is a member of the Committee on Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs, of the Secretariat of Child and Youth Protection, of the Committee on Domestic Justice and Human Development and of the Special Assembly Planning Committee, and is Chairman of the Subcommittee on the Catholic Campaign for Human Development.

In addition to English, he speaks Spanish. - Zenit

Guidelines for Fast and Abstinence during Lent

Abstinence is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age or older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years, on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. One full meal is allowed on these days. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids and medication are allowed. If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.
